When writing a caption, the first sentence should be in present tense that describes the action in the picture. The 2nd/3rd sentences should be in past tense and give background info and possibly a quote. Incorporate quotes into your captions; ask subjects what they enjoyed, found surprising, or the results of what happened in the picture. As a rule of thumb, try not to begin captions with names.
