I've applied for the CPP program for Fall 2021 and I have received my acceptance letter. However, do I need to fill out the WCPSS form for CCP?

Wake Tech doesn't require the WCPSS Form distributed by your high school.

It looks like you are ready for step 7-8-9 for Wake Tech CCP

Does the student's grade in the CCP course get included in the student's high school GPA?

Can a student change their pathway?

Students can change their pathway upon the completion of the Change of Status Form provided by the CCP Team.

Can students take CCP classes in the summer even if it is their first time taking CCP classes?

Yes! As long as they are a current high school student they can begin in the Summer. **Note: Current 10th grade students must meet the 9th/10th grade eligibility requirements for Summer (if they choose to enroll for the Summer term) and 11th/12th grade for Fall.

Does ENG 111 - writing and inquiry and/or ENG 112 writing and research in the disciplines replace English III and/or English IV? and If you pass AP Seminar, does that qualify to replace either ENG 111 or ENG 112?

English 3 = Eng 111, 112, and ENG 231

AP Seminar is an elective course.

Do I need to take any calculus classes in order to take Calculus I or is Pre-Calc enough to qualify?

As long as you qualify for the College Transfer Pathway, you have a variety of math courses you can enroll in which includes college Pre-Calculus and Calculus. If we are applying for next year's courses through PowerSchool do we register for a full year of courses if we have yet to apply for CCP?

PowerSchool and Wake Tech aren't related. You should plan for a full Heritage HS schedule, in the event Wake Tech course enrollment doesn't work out (classes are full, aren't offered when/where you need, etc)

Do we just start this process on our own or do we have to contact a counselor first?

You can begin the process on your own. Wake Tech highly encourages that you utilize the new student checklist to guide you through the process.

Do you guys have any business pathways for college transfer?

What pathway would I need to go into if I'm trying to get into the dental hygiene program?

Unfortunately, we don't offer Dental Hygiene within the CCP program. You may want to review the College Transfer Pathway to see which General Education courses can transfer into the traditional Dental Hygiene program at Wake Tech.

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Is the culinary program the same?

Yes, correct. Unfortunately, we don't offer Culinary in CCP, but a few general education courses may be available within the traditional program.
