

Dual Enrollment Opportunities at Heritage High

Dual enrollment is becoming increasingly popular and meets the needs of students who seek additional high school credit, college credit, or certifications. Students taking courses at another institution while enrolled at Heritage High are considered to be dually enrolled. Dual enrollment includes many options. See below for more details. For all courses, students need to consider how and when courses will be taken along with required core courses.

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| Career and College Promise (Wake Tech) www.waketech.edu | Numerous courses available to students under career pathway or college transfer options. Eligibility can include gpa and testing requirements, depending on college transfer or pathway course(s) selected. | Complete online application at Wake Tech and WCPSS dual enrollment form. There will be an additional Career and College Promise form required. Students must be ready to report to Wake Tech campus to register for specific course. For fall enrollment, sign up for info session in March/April. For spring enrollment, sign up for info session in September/October. | Mature learner who can handle demands of college course, while maintaining positive standard of learning with courses at base school. Student is responsible for transportation and the cost of books. Tuition is paid through the state funded Career and College Promise program. |
| Academic Enrichment Opportunities (NCSU) www.ncsu.edu | Numerous courses available to students with at least a 3.5 gpa. Student is responsible for verifying prerequisites. | Download and complete the AEO form and the WCPSS dual enrollment form. Contact AEO representatives at NCSU to complete enrollment. | Students are responsible for tuition, books and transportation to campus. Must be a mature and responsible learner who takes initiative |
| North Carolina Virtual Public School www.ncvps.org | Numerous online courses available to students during fall, spring and summer sessions. Credit recovery available for specified core subjects. Advanced Placement courses available (scheduled year-long) | Complete the NCVPS application and WCPSS dual enrollment form. | Student must be a mature, independent learner, willing to log in daily to complete assignments. This is a cost-free program sponsored by State Dept. of Public Instruction. |
| Online High School Courses | There are several accredited online high schools offering courses at ½ or full credit | Complete enrollment through the specific institution and the WCPSS dual enrollment form. Commonly used schools include Keystone, PennFoster, Brigham Young, American High School, Compuhigh | Student must be a mature, independent learner, with the ability to self-advocate and complete assignments. Student is responsible for tuition and fees. |
